And, last June, Visit England voted us the best visitor attraction in the country for accessibility and inclusivity.

We have so much to offer, and we are now looking to recruit two more Trustees who can bring additional skills and experience to our Board, and a Zoo Insights Panel to give us their ideas, feedback, opinions, and recommendations, and who can share our vision and enthusiasm for this zoo.
